#### License to use the work

#### §1 General Provisions

- 1. This document constitutes a license agreement concluded between the Author and the Publishing House, specifying the rules for the use of the work submitted for publication in "Language, Culture, Politics. International Journal."
- 2. The author declares that he is the exclusive owner of the copyright to the work and has full right to grant a license under the terms specified in this document.
- 3. The license is granted on the basis of Creative Commons (CC BY).

## §2 Scope of the License

- 1. The Author grants the Publishing House a non-exclusive, worldwide license to use the work in the following fields of exploitation:
  - 1) recording and reproducing the work using all available techniques (including printing, digital and electronic techniques) on any media;
  - 2) making the work publicly available in such a way that everyone can have access to it at a place and time of their choosing, including the Internet;
  - 3) dissemination of the work as part of the activities of the Publishing House, including its publication in "Language, Culture, Politics. International Journal."
- 2. The license also includes the right to translate, adapt, change and create derivative works of the work, to the extent permitted by the selected Creative Commons license.

### §3 Creative Commons License Terms

# §4 Liability and Guarantees

- 1. The author declares that the work is original and does not infringe the rights of third parties, in particular copyrights, rights to trademarks, patents and other intellectual property rights.
